## Work in Kenya begins

Nehemiah Construction Ministries UK became a registered charity in 2009 and works mainly in the sub-sahara region of north west Kenya. Multi purpose facilities have been constructed, water related projects carried out and numerous boreholes drilled or refurbished.



## Too much sun and no rain

In the regions of Pokot and Turkana, women and children in particular walk on average 5 kilometres every day to look for water. The water they find is often contaminated either visibly with sediment or invisibly with bacteria or viruses. This leads to disease, suffering and death, especially among the young and other vulnerable people. The World Health Organisation (WHO) report that one child dies every 20 seconds in the developing world. There is too much sun and little or no rain, which means there is a constant cycle of drought, famine and death. Life is hard in this unforgiving environment.



## Water for all

Nehemiah Construction Ministries UK drills boreholes in or near villages or small towns. Good, clean safe drinking water for all is provided from hand operated pumps. Provision of a constant supply of water leads to proper sanitation and hygiene. It also helps in growing drought resistant crops and animal husbandry skills appropriate to the arid environment.
